## Becoming a Jacksonville Champion for LGBTQIA+ Children and Youth

The following web-based education modules and links provide an introduction to the care of LGBTQIA+ children and youth. Please complete these trainings as soon as possible, as they define a standard of care that JYE is committed to provide to our patients. Paraphrased from Fenway's website, is this additional information:

Continuing Medical Education (CME) and Continuing Education Units (CEU) will be available free for many of Fenway's programs, including their live and on-demand webinars, learning modules, and more. Fenway is certified to offer prescribed credits from the American Academy of Family Physicians. The AAFP Prescribed credit is accepted by the American Medical Association as equivalent to AMA PRA Category I Credit<sup>TM</sup> and the American Nurses Credentialing Center accepts credits awarded by the AAFP.

For Physicians: AAFP Prescribed credit is accepted by the American Medical Association as equivalent to AMA PRA Category 1 Credit<sup>TM</sup> toward the AMA Physician's Recognition Award. When applying for the AMA PRA, Prescribed credit earned must be reported as Prescribed, not as Category 1.

For Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants, Nurses, Medical Assistants: AAFP Prescribed credit is accepted by the following organizations. Please contact them directly about how participants should report the credit they earned.

- American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC)

For Other Health Professionals: Confirm equivalency of credits with relevant licensing body.

To receive CME/CEU credit, you will need to register and create a password. Personal information is used for issuing a credit certificate and for storing that credit in the National LGBT Health Education website database (you can return to your account to see what credits you have already earned). Information on the Healthcare Equality Index: The National LGBT Health Education Center has partnered with the Human Rights Campaign (HRC) Foundation to offer our webinars as on-going training for the HRC Foundation's Healthcare Equality Index (HEI). All webinars offered by The Education Center are eligible to count towards the on-going LGBT education training requirement in the HEI. In order to receive HEI credit, each participant must watch the webinar or learning module all the way through, and complete the evaluation survey required for CME/CEU credit. To complete the evaluation, click the "evaluation survey" button after viewing the on-demand video. Video play is tracked for accreditation.

How to Receive HEI On-going Training Credit: To receive HEI on-going training credit, you will need to register and provide your HRC Facility ID. Personal information is used for issuing a credit certificate and for storing that credit in the National LGBT Health Education website database (you can return to your account to see what credits you have already earned). You will not need to reenter your information. The Education Center will automatically report on those who have requested HEI credit for our training to the HRC Foundation.
